

OUALITY OPERATION

From the product analyses and checks carried out on the materials provided within the recovery plant, there are many impurities and non-target fractions in the multimaterial separate collection (plastic and metals) and in particular with regard to plastic waste.

Wrong disposals generate problems and additional costs every day that burden the entire recovery chain. For this reason, greater attention and knowledge on the correct recycling of plastic materials is essential.

Plastic is perhaps the type of collection that generates the most doubts in waste separation, this is because there are so many different types of plastics.

The "Plastic Focus" communication campaign aims to make it clear and simple what is thrown into the plastic household bin.

PACKAGING ONLY!

The fundamental rule to follow is that only packaging plastic should be disposed of, that is, all plastic materials used to contain or wrap objects or food, such as bottles and flasks, food trays, polystyrene, plastic film, or plastic wrap.

WHAT GOES INTO PLASTIC Some examples:

- Bottles for water, soft drinks, oil, juices, milk, etc...
- Iced tea plastic cup, bottles of detergents, soaps, various products
- Tubes for creams, sauces, syrups, etc...
- · Rigid plastic or polystyrene confectionery packaging, transparent boxes, rigid/flexible packaging for foods in general (cold cuts, cheeses, pasta, etc.)
- Food trays (eggs, ice cream, etc.)
- Containers for yogurt, cream cheese, desserts
- Fruit and vegetable mesh bags
- Containers for packaging various products (cosmetics, wet wipes, powdered products)
- · Plastic bags for food in general (pasta, rice, chips, candy, snacks, etc...)
- · Bags for gardening products, detergents and pet food
- · Small plastic packaging (wrapper of bottles, toilet paper, etc...)
- Polystyrene (if large, reduce it in size)
- Plastic blisters and moulded wrappers
- · Materials for the protection and transport of goods (films, bubble wrap)

RECYCLING TIPS



Remove food residues!

Plastic should not be washed, but in case of very dirty packaging/ containers, it is good to make sure that there is no food residue that could cause bad odours.



Empty and crush!

Empty the packaging as best you can and, if possible, crush it to reduce the volume before throwing them.

COMMON MISTAKES

NO glass



Throw it into the glass container



NO Tetra Pak

Throw it in the paper container

NO Electronics



Take it to the Mobile Collection Point or in the dedicated containers for the MICROWEEE



Throw it in the paper container

NO Bioplastics



Throw them into the organic waste container

NO Disposable Gloves



Throw them into the non-recyclable waste container

NO large plastic items NO Tubes



Brina them to the Mobile Collection Point


