

DID YOU KNOW THAT...

The non-recyclable waste container is an excellent indicator of good recycling.

If it remains almost empty it means that we have separated well all other recyclable materials.

Regional and provincial taxes are applied to each tonne of waste disposed of in a landfill: recycling also allows to reduce the costs related to landfill disposal.

Proper separation of waste generated at home allows to achieve a very strong reduction in the amounts of waste that ends up in landfills, with consequent environmental benefits.

The appropriately treated dry fraction can become an alternative secondary solid fuel (CSS) to traditional fossil fuels.

Non-recyclable waste is the only fraction of urban waste that cannot be delivered to the Municipal Sanitation Services.



LET'S REDUCE NON-RECYCLABLE WASTE AND LET'S INCREASE RECYCLING

Communication campaign for the improvement of separate waste collection and non-recyclable waste



NON-RECYCLABLE WASTE, DOES NOT MEAN MIXING EVERYTHING!

Can you give an example of a non-recyclable waste item that you throw away every day?

If we think about all the waste we throw away every day, we'll find that most of them are recyclable and can turn into new resources (such as paper, plastic, metals, food leftovers etc...).

Non-recyclable waste is very little, only 20% !

This category of waste is given different names: undifferentiated waste, dry waste, non-recyclable, residual dry, black bin. In any case, the concept is the same, the materials that go into the non-recyclable waste are not recoverable, recyclable or compostable.

SMALL GESTURES THAT CAN MAKE A DIFFERENCE

SEPARATE, carefully, non-recyclable waste from other recyclable materials, such as paper, plastic, glass, aluminium, but above all from organic waste.

PACK, correctly, the waste in the semi-transparent bags, tightly closed and placed in the containers provided.

THROW in the non-recyclable only the waste that cannot be recycled, therefore the one that does not go in the other containers, or all those objects that are made up of multiple inseparable materials.

NEVER LEAVE the waste outside the appropriate containers or along the roads and respect the collection schedule.

WHAT TO THROW IN THE NON-RECYCLABLE WASTE

Let's find out specifically everything that can be conferred in the non-recyclable waste container:

- baby and adult diapers, bed wetting mats, sanitary napkins (**or dedicated pick-up service**)
- disposable masks and gloves
- cigarette butts (well extinguished)
- oiled, laminated and thermal paper (receipts, etc.)
- plastic cutlery (beware of bioplastics!)
- rubber and hard plastic toys
- hard plastic coffee capsules
- CDs, DVDs, cassettes and videocassettes
- objects in ceramics, crystal, porcelain, pyrex and glass ceramics (glasses, etc.)
- vacuum cleaner dust or garbage
- X-rays, photo rolls and slides
- incandescent light bulbs
- pens, markers, adhesive tape and stationery
- synthetic litter and animal waste
- lighters
- durable hard plastic goods (toothbrush, brushes etc...)
- tights and stockings
- rugs, rags, fabrics, clothing
- mirrors

ATTENTION

SOILED WASTE CAN BE RECYCLED!

Never throw them in the non-recyclable waste (e.g. pizza cartons, biodegradable plastic plates, plastic trays and food containers etc...)

COMMON MISTAKES

SOME PAPER!

Books, sheets and notebooks are recyclable. Other types of paper, such as baking paper, laminated paper, adhesive paper, and chemical paper (receipts), should be placed in the non-recyclable waste bin.

SO MUCH PLASTIC!

A large amount of plastic packaging is disposed of (polystyrene, bags, plates, cups) which is actually recyclable.

A LOT OF ORGANIC WASTE!

Organic waste weighs down non-recyclable waste and increases the amount of waste to be sent to landfill, with a consequent negative impact on costs, but above all on the environment.
